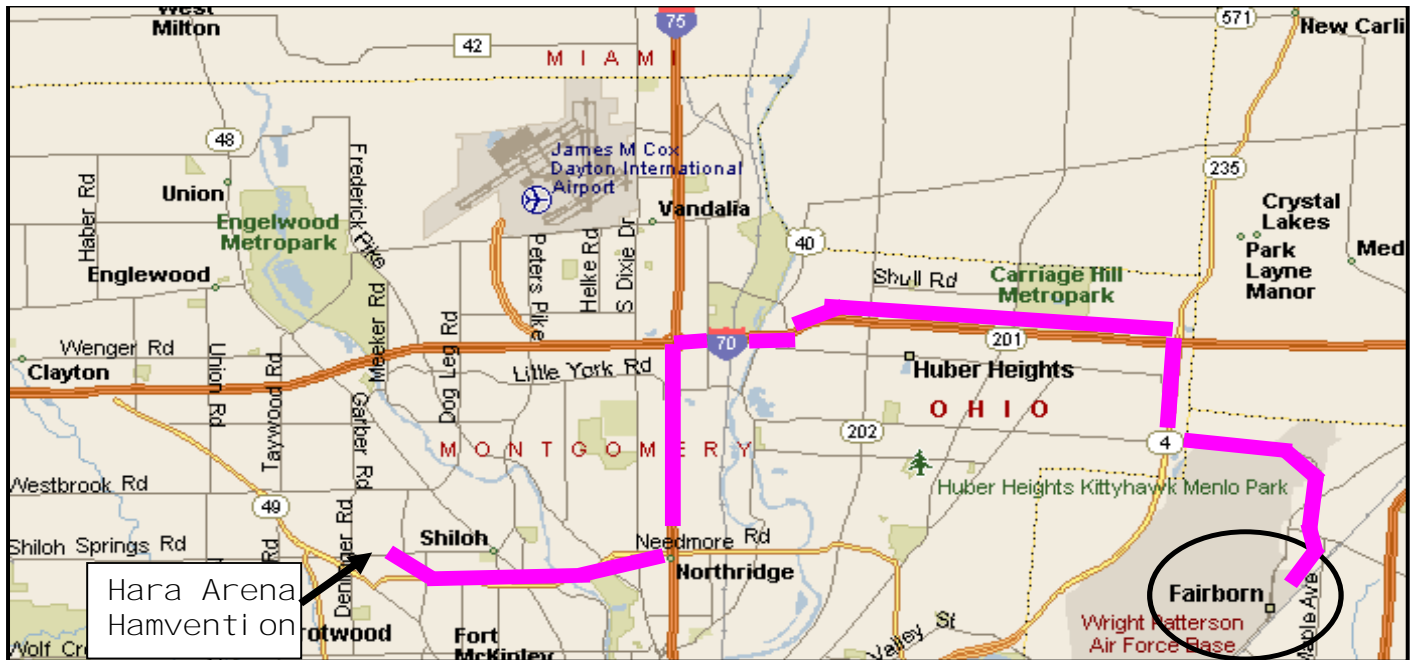


Hamvention Friday Night ATV Dinner

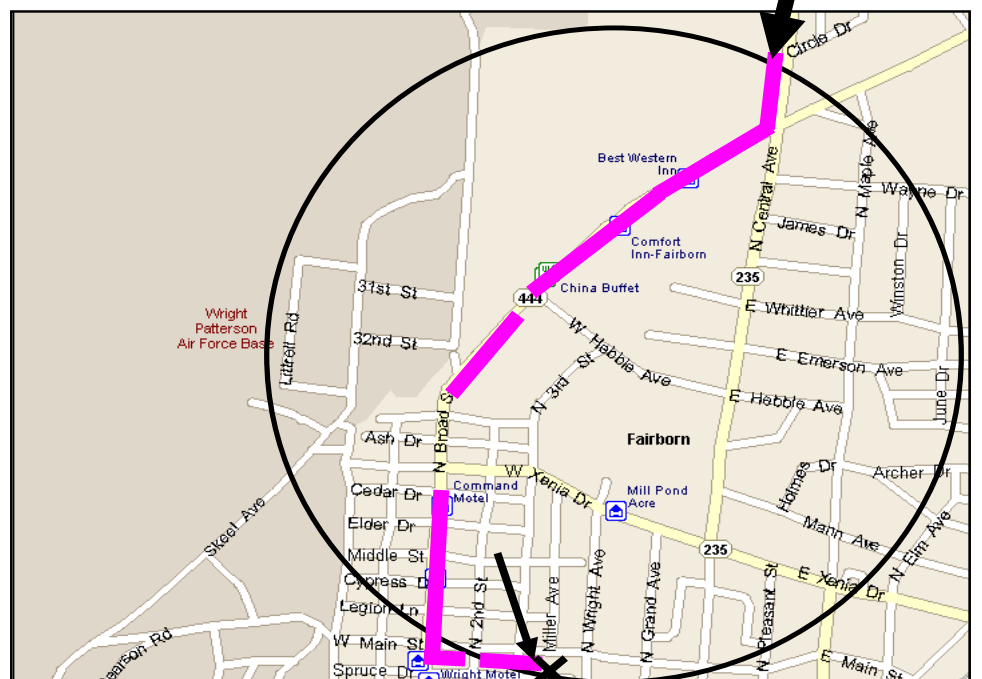

Preview of the forum topics:

ATV Antics is a humorous presentation about ATV operation and ham radio/TV comedy by Gordon West known to many as Gordo. His opening show is a must see and has been enjoyed each year at the Dayton Hamvention.

ATV Quad-Copters & RC Planes is a presentation on using adding an ATV transmitter and camera to Quad-Copters and RC airplanes to provide a front row seat view as if you were inside the aircraft and it's public service benefits. Bill Brown has been active in ATV RC aircraft and balloon projects with over 30 years experience.

DATV Amplifier Linearization is a down to earth technical presentation about driver and power amplifier linearization techniques for digital and analog amateur television. Part of the presentation will be via power point and video clips showing the amplifier under test on a work bench. Mike Collis is a broadcast transmitter engineer for CBS television with over 20 years experience with digital and analog broadcast transmitters and 40 years in ATV.

DATV-Express Is an DATV exciter project by Art Towslee and many other ATVers that was a work in progress for two years but now is ready for market. The exciter can make most formats of DATV and operate from VHF through 2.5 GHz. Art will cover design and operation capabilities of the exciter board and how you can build an DATV station Art is a retired design engineer with decades of experience.

ATN Booth:

Amateur Television Network will have their booth again this year right across from Gordon West's Amateur Radio School booth. This is a good place to check on ATV activities at Dayton, ask technical questions and see ATV demonstrations.
